INTERPRETATION

- Pass: Successful completion of written comp requirement. May have some minor issues, but still successful completion. No edits will be required.
- 1st time Fail: Significant deficiencies seen in the written examination. Student will be asked to address the weakness in some way such as: revise the answer, write an answer to a new question, do further reading and then meet for another oral examination on that question, etc.
- 2nd time Fail: Significant deficiencies still seen in the written examination otherwise known as unsuccessful completion of the requirement. Dismissal from the doctoral program will be recommended by the committee if failed a 2nd time.
- Pass: Successful completion of oral comp requirement. Very minor issues with responses.
- Fail: Significant deficiencies in oral responses. Student is not clear on expansion of responses. No further opportunity to pass the oral comp exam. Dismissal from the doctoral program will be recommended by the committee if graded as a "fail."
