

B.S. in Allied Health Sciences

The BS with a major in Allied Health Sciences requires 48 hours in addition to 15 hours of TCU core associated requirements. Students pursuing an Allied Health emphasis track must complete 18 hours of Allied Health Sciences core courses, between 26 to 33 hours of emphasis area courses, and 12 hours of TCU core associated requirements.
